Coronavirus: In light of the current health concerns about the Coronavirus, we will be following the advice of the Church of England available on the CofE website.

This means we will be introducing a number of changes to how we normally do things.

- Please stand to receive communion so as to avoid touching the communion rail.
- We will offer Communion in one kind only to all communicants i.e. the consecrated bread, with the priest alone taking the wine.
- We will suspend handshaking and any other direct physical contact during the sharing of the Peace.
- There will be no direct physical contact as part of a blessing at the communion rail.
- Please place your offering for the collection in the plate before the start of the service, as we will not be passing it from person to person.
- We have hand sanitiser in church and ask that you please use it as you arrive.
